

The Abilympics movement is an all-Russian association of the concerned parties of Russian public authorities, as well as state authorities of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and the representatives of all-Russian public associations and movements. The Abilympics movement also involves all-Russian interregional and regional associations of people with disabilities and specialized non-profit organizations and businesses, including all concerned employers, with a view to developing sociocultural inclusion in society, expanding the list of new professions for people with disabilities, providing effective career guidance and motivation for receiving vocational education for people with disabilities or health limitations, as well as promoting their further occupations and employment. In Russia, the Abilympics championships are held annually in accordance with the approved Executive Order of Government of the Russian Federation of February 26, 2018 No.312-p. The events are organized and supported by the federal authorities and concerned structures.

By the Order of the President of the Russian Federation of February 26, 2018 No. 312-p, the Government of the Russian Federation established the annual holding of the Abilympics competitions in the Russian Federation.

ORGANIZERS

The Abilympics national championship is organized by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, the Government of Moscow, Federal Institute for the Development of Vocational Education and Training and other organizations authorized by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation.



TARGET GROUP



The target group includes citizens of the Russian Federation with disabilities and/or health limitations aged 14 and above, disabled adults and children living in state institutions or those who became disabled as adults due to various emergency situations, as well as foreign citizens with a residence permit in the Russian Federation.



JUDGES

Persons with the necessary practical experience, professional qualities, knowledge, skills and abilities. The judges can be representatives of an employer or an educational institute involved in organizing and coordinating judgement in a particular contest category at the contest venue.



VOLUNTEERS

Students of educational organizations, teaching staff, medical workers, accompanying persons, parents (legal representatives), representatives of youth associations of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and other persons volunteering to support the Abilympics movement.



ORGANIZERS

Federal and regional executive authorities, vocational education organizations, public organizations of disabled people, autonomous non-profit organizations.



PARTNERS

Persons and/or legal entities, co-organizers of the Abilympics championships providing judges, equipment, consumables and grant prizes as well as ensuring further employment of participants and winners of the championships.

CATEGORIES OF CONTESTANTS



Schoolchildren the category includes persons, aged 14 and above, with disabilities and/or health limitations undertaking educational programs of basic general or secondary general education as well.



Students the category includes persons with disabilities and/or health limitations doing vocational training courses and/or basic vocational training programs: secondary vocational education.



Specialists the category includes persons with disabilities embracing graduates of secondary vocational and higher education institutions, employed or seeking for employment, as well as those who became disabled as adults due to various emergency situations.

ORGANIZING STRUCTURE

OF THE ABILYMPICS MOVEMENT



ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The structure defines strategic directions and priorities for the development of the Abilympics championships, determines areas of international cooperation, organizes interdepartmental interaction with the view to employing and promoting further occupations for the Abilympics movement participants.

COORDINATING PARTNER COUNCIL

The structure promotes the involvement of employers in the Abilympics movement, assists in further employment and organization of industrial training apprenticeships for participants and winners of the national Abilympics championship. The structure also promotes the development of new contest categories of the Abilympics championships.

WORKING GROUP

The structure approves the list of basic contest categories, the Abilympics activity program, working papers (regulations and other documents) regulating the holding and organization of the championships. The structure coordinates organizing and holding activities of the national championship, determines the dates and place of the event, approves the motto of the championship as well as the composition of the Contest Categories Councils.

ABILYMPICS NATIONAL CENTRE

Primary Coordinator of the Abilympics movement in the Russian Federation – Federal Institute for the Development of Vocational Education and Training.

CONTEST CATEGORIES COUNCIL

The structure develops and updates competition tasks for the Abilympics championships on specific categories included in the list of core contest categories of the national championship or in the list of regional contest categories. The structure also develops new contest categories in accordance with the needs of the labor market and the demands of employers.





REGIONAL LEVEL

REGIONAL ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The structure sets the date and place of the Abilympics championship, approves the organizational plan for holding the championship, as well as the list of contest categories in the constituent entities of the Russian Federation.

COORDINATING PARTNER COUNCIL

The structure provides assistance in professional development and further employment, including organizing apprenticeships for participants and winners of the regional championship in a constituent entity of the Russian Federation. The structure also develops regional contest categories of the Abilympics championships.

ABILYMPICS DEVELOPING CENTRES

The structure ensures the development of the Abilympics movement in a constituent entity of the Russian Federation, organizes and holds the regional Abilympics championship, monitors the employment of Abilympics participants, conducts works, selects the primary and regional contest categories judges in a constituent entity of the Russian Federation.

ABILYMPICS VOLUNTEER CENTRES

The structure develops, selects and coordinates the activities of volunteers for holding Abilympics championships and other events for people with disabilities and health limitations.

REGIONAL JUDGES TRAINING CENTRE

The structure provides training to regional Abilympics judges in an additional professional program.

ABILYMPICS YOUTH ASSOCIATION

The structure provides popularization of the Abilympics movement as well as professions and specialties for employment of participants of the Abilympics championships. The structure also implements social projects and develops inclusive education in a constituent entity of the Russian Federation.




ABILYMPICS MOVEMENT IN NUMBERS


The number of contestants of the Abilympics National Championships (people)





The number of contest categories of the Abilympics National Championship (pcs.)




The number of constituent entities of the Russian Federation holding regional championships (pcs.)




ABILYMPICS MOVEMENT IN NUMBERS


As of July 1, 2024, 89,891 people from 89 constituent entities of the Russian Federation took part in the monitoring with a cumulative total (2018 - 2023). 57,492 of the people who took part in monitoring were unique participants.

Unique participants of the Abilympics Championships (2018-2023) according to International Classification of Diseases (ICD)






Unique Participants of the Abilympics Championships according to disability degrees













Unique participants of the Abilympics Championships according to Age Groups
















EMPLOYMENT OF ABILYMPICS PARTICIPANTS

One of the main goals of the Abilympics Movement Development Concept in the Russian Federation for 2023 - 2030 is to expand employment opportunities for people with disabilities and to support contestants in developing skills for new professional activities, as well as further employment and organization of apprenticeships for participants in the Abilympics championships within the social cooperation with employers.




